

Rite Aid Weekly Couponing Guide

This is the weekly guide for 7/17-7/23 to use while shopping for Operation: Slickdeal. These guides are meant for the new coupon shopper learning the ropes. These deals are the cream of the crop, so you will have to shop early to beat the competition. We are concentrating on simply using coupons from the Sunday paper from the current week, so all you need is two copies of this week's Sunday paper. (From July 17, 2011)

Once again, we are focusing on using only coupons from this week and last week. If you would like to delve into shopping using more coupons or older coupons, please see the weekly thread. They will be happy to point you in the right direction and answer any questions

Here is what we'll be buying this week:

Resolve Spray n Wash – They are on sale this week for \$2 for \$4 (with the coupon on page 10 of your Sunday paper insert), and you will receive a \$1 UP+ Reward when you buy 2. There is also a \$.75 off 1 coupon available [here](#). And there are \$.50 off coupons in the Sunday paper (you'll need two).

* Note if they do not have Resolve Spray n Wash, this deal is also valid for Murphy's Oil Soap, Fabuloso or Suavitel. If you end up getting Murphy's Oil Soap, use a \$.50 off coupon located [here](#).

Crest Toothpaste 3D White or Oral-B Cross Action Toothbrush - There is a coupon in the Sunday paper for \$2.99, and you will receive a \$1.50 UP+ Reward.

Your transaction will look like this:

2 Resolve Spray n Wash's: \$6.99
1 Toothbrush or Toothpaste: \$2.99
Subtotal: \$6.99

Use two of the coupons linked above for the Resolve Spray n Wash, which will make your total \$5.99. Now, if you followed the guide from last week, you should have \$6 in usable UP+ Rewards. So you will need to filler, usually something small by the register. Just make sure it's not perishable and can be donated as you will need to donate everything on the receipt to Operation Homefront, a pack of gum or something small. Then you can use your \$6 in +UP Rewards and the purchase costs you nothing out of pocket! If you ended last week with only two \$2 UP+ Rewards, then no filler is needed, and your out of pocket will be a little higher.

The limit on the toothbrush is 1, so this one cannot be done again. The limit on the Spray n Wash family is 3. So you could buy more of that, using either the printable coupons linked above or more Sunday paper coupons. The net cost for the Spray n Wash ins only \$1, that is a pretty good price! You could also do up to three sets of the Spray n Wash family in one transaction, using both the printable coupons and Sunday paper coupons, as long as you do not go over the limit of 3 deals, totalling six bottles of the cleansers listed above. Remember the deal must be done in pairs.
