

Walgreens Weekly Couponing Guide – Part 3

Well, here we are at week three. If you have been following the guides so far, you should be edging up on the \$100 retail mark, with minimal out of pocket expense. Once again, start with picking up two Sunday papers. You can find extra inserts at times at Starbucks, local diners, coffee shops, or my favorite, Grandma's house!

Remember, Register Rewards will print at the register as you buy certain items. You can use these coupons like cash on your next purchase. We'll be using the system with coupons for maximum savings. Here are the items we'll be purchasing, and coupons we'll be using this week.

Perfection Tampons – normally \$1.50, you will receive a \$1.50 Register Reward, so the item is free.

Scrunci – On sale for 2/\$3, you will get a \$3.00 Register Reward, so the item is free.

Irish Spring Deodorant – On sale for 2/\$6. You have two options here: 2.7oz or 3oz antiperspirant/deodorant or 15oz or 18oz bodywash. There is a coupon in the Sunday paper for \$1 off any Irish Spring Deodorant. There is also a coupon for \$.50 off the body wash. And you will receive \$4 back in Register Rewards. So, when all is said and done, the items are free!

Loreal Everpure – Normally \$5.99. There is a \$2 Loreal Everpure Shampoo/Conditioner in the Sunday paper, and another \$2 Loreal Everpure Treatment coupon. You will also receive a \$3 Register Reward. Your net cost will be \$.99.

DenTek Comfort Clean Flosser – Normally \$2.99, you will receive a \$2 Register Reward, so the item will be \$.99.

Composition Notebook – Normally \$.99, there is a \$.80 off coupon in the IVC pamphlet at the front of the store.

Pure Silk Shave Cream – There is a coupon in the Sunday paper that makes this item \$.99. If you still have the newspaper from 7/10, there is an \$.80 off coupon, making the net cost \$.19. This is a buy price! The coupon may have been regional, or you may not have the newspaper, so we won't include it in the transactions below, but if you have the coupon, go ahead and get it. Remember to give the manufacturer's coupons first, then Register Rewards, then the coupon from the IVC pamphlet.

You should have 2 \$4 Register Rewards from last week, so we will use that today.

Transaction #1

2 Irish Spring Deodorants (You will use both coupons from both papers on these)

2 Scrunci (Page 10 of the insert)

1 Perfection Tampon (Page 8 of the insert)

Make sure the Register Rewards machine has a steady green light. It will ring up like this:

Deodorant x2: \$6
Scrunci x2: \$3
Tampon: \$1.50
Subtotal: \$10.50

Then you will hand the cashier the following coupons.

-\$1 Irish Spring coupon
-\$1 Irish Spring coupon
-\$4 Register Reward from last week
-\$4 Register Reward from last week

New Total: \$.50

You will now receive 3 Register Rewards, totaling \$8.50, so you paid \$.50 but increased your Register Rewards by \$.50, nice turn around!

Please note that this transaction needs no fillers because you have three items with no manufacturer's coupons to use on them (scrunci and perfection tampons) and you are paying a few cents out of pocket, so you don't need a few more cents to use your Register Rewards.

Transaction #2
Loreal Everpure
DenTek Comfort Clean Flosser
Composition Notebook

Make sure the Register Rewards machine has a steady green light. It will ring up like this:

Loreal Everpure: \$5.99
DenTek: \$2.99
Notebook: \$.99
Subtotal: \$9.97

Then you will hand the cashier the following coupons:

-\$2 Loreal coupon
-\$4 Register Reward from the first transaction
-\$3 Register reward from the first transaction
-\$.80 coupon from the IVC pamphlet for the notebook (page 5)

New Total: \$.17

You will receive two more Register Rewards totaling \$5. Plus, you still have the \$1.50 Register Reward from the last transaction, for a new total of \$6.50. You started the week with \$8, for a net loss of \$1.50 in Register Rewards. You got over \$20 retail value for \$.67 out of pocket, add that to the Register Reward "loss" for a net cost of \$2.17, about 90% savings – pretty sweet!

You've used \$7 in Register Rewards and got back \$5, so a loss of \$2, but you could go and do transaction \$1 in a variation with body wash instead of deodorant and then do \$2 again. Just remember

not use the Register Rewards from the same deal to buy again or your Register Rewards will not print.
